The Physical Geography (GEOG) Program is looking to hire Graduate Teaching Assistants (GTAs) and Undergraduate Teaching Assistants (UTAs). Applicants should be enrolled as full-time students at UBC Okanagan (a full-time student is defined as a minimum of 24 credits over the 2 terms of the 2019W Session). Qualifications include understanding of the discipline and good grades. Applications for UTA positions would be preferably students with 4th year standing who are GEOG, EESC or FWSC Majors. Part time students can be considered. All applicants, including international students, must be permitted to work in Canada until at least April 30, 2020.

Teaching Assistants may be involved in the following:

- delivering lab experiments (including set up & take down)
- marking midterms, assignments, tests, quizzes and exams
- leading discussion periods and tutorials
- invigilating tests and examinations
- providing academic assistance to students during office hours
- various duties as appointed by the supervisor

TA's hired **must register and complete** The TA Credentialing Foundations Certificate provided by the Centre for Teaching and Learning. Sessions are held at the start of term. Information will be provided to hired applicants. For more information visit:

The exact hours of these positions vary, but will not exceed 12 hours per week, for a maximum 384 hours Sept 1, 2019 - April 30, 2020 (considered full time). Successful candidates will be assigned duties in one or more undergraduate courses. Wages for these positions are:

Graduate TA1 (PhD Program) \$32.79 per hour (\$12,591.36 annual maximum)

Graduate TA2 (Master's Program) \$31.59 per hour (\$12,130.56 annual maximum) Undergraduate TA \$16.13 per hour (\$6,193.92 annual maximum)
