The Earth, Environmental and Geographic Sciences (EEGS) Department is looking to hire Graduate Teaching Assistants (GTAs) and Undergraduate Teaching Assistants (UTAs). Applicants should be enrolled as full-time students at UBC Okanagan (a full-time student is defined as a minimum of 24 credits over the 2 terms of the 2025W Session); although part time students may be considered. Qualifications include an understanding of the discipline and good grades. Applicants for UTA positions are preferably 4th year standing students who are EESC, FWSC, or SUST Majors. All applicants, including international students, must be within the Canadian border for the entire duration of the active TA employment, and permitted to work in Canada until at least April 30, 2026.

It is anticipated that all EEGS GTA and UTA positions for the 2025W academic year will be for **in-person** course components; therefore, you must live in, or near, Kelowna for the duration of your TA position(s).

Teaching Assistants may be involved in the following:

- delivering lab sessions (including set up & take down)
- marking midterms, assignments, tests, quizzes and exams
- · leading discussion periods and tutorials
- invigilating tests and examinations
- providing academic assistance to students during office hours
- various duties as appointed by the supervisor

The exact hours of these positions vary, but will not exceed 12 hours per week, for a maximum 384 hours Sept 1, 2025 - April 30, 2026 (considered full time). Successful candidates will be assigned duties in one or more undergraduate courses. Wages* for these positions are:

Graduate TA1 (PhD Program) \$40.48 per hour (\$15,544.32 annual maximum)
Graduate TA2 (Master's Program) \$39.01 per hour (\$14,979.84 annual maximum)
Undergraduate TA \$22.26 per hour (\$8,547.84 annual maximum)
*BCGEU Wages are current as of July 1, 2024. If BCGEU wages change, new wages will be reflected in official Offer Letters.

All positions are subject to budgetary approval and are based on enrolment and lab sections.
